LA FAMILLE ET MOI

How do we say in French? (Comment dit-on en Français?)

Tell your friend good morning. Bonjour / Salut

How do you ask a person how are you? Comment ça va?/ ça va? / Comment vas-tu? /Comment allez- vous

You want to know about your friend's father and mother. What do you ask?

Comment va ton père?/ Comment va ta mère?

Your friend wants to know about your brother and sister. What does he/she ask?

Comment va ton frere? /comment va ta soeur?

Tell your uncle/mother/aunt/friend/ you are fine. Je vais bien. / ça va bien.

Your sister helps you with your homework, tell her thank you very much.

Merci beaucoup.

Tell your mother you are not feeling well. Je ne vais pas bien.

You teacher wants to know your name what does she ask? Comment t'appelles-tu?

You visit your cousin's home you want to know his friend's name. what you do say?- Comment s'appelle ton ami?

Your uncle brought home a girl friend. You want to know her name. what do you ask?- Comment s'appelle ton amie?

You want to know the name of your friend's mother/father's. What do you ask?

Comment s'appelle ta mère?/ Comment s'appelle ton père?

You want to know the name of your friend's sister. What do you ask?

Comment s'appelle ta soeur ?

You want to know the name of your friend's brother. What do you ask?

Comment s'appelle ton frère?

Your uncle is about to leave the house, how does he say goodbye? Au revoir

You want to know how to spell a word. What do you ask? Comment ça s'écrit?

You want to introduce your friend to someone . what do you say?

Je te présente

A friend introduce you to someone. what do you say? Enchanté de faire votre connaissance.

Ask a new student where he/she is from. D'ou es-tu?/ d'ou êtes –vous?

Ask a new student what is his/her nationality. Quel est ta nationalité

Tell someone where you are from. Je suis de la Barbade.

Tell your teacher your nationality. Je suis Barbadien/ne

Tell your teacher in which country you live. J'habite au Canada.

Tell your friend you live in Martinique. J'habite á la Martinique

You want to find out what sort of person someone is. What do you ask?

Quelle sorte de personne es-tu?/êtes-vous?

Your teacher wants to know how tall you are. What does she ask? Quelle est votre taille?

Tell your friend I am tall. Je suis grand/ je suis grande

Tell your friend I am small. Je suis petit/ je suis petite

Tell your friend your brother is intelligent. Mon frère est intelligent.

You want to know the colour of your friend's hair. What do you ask? Quelle est la couleur de tes cheveux?

Tell your teacher you have black hair. J'ai les cheveux noirs.

You want to know the colour of your friend's eyes. What do you ask?

Quelle est la couleur de tes yeux ?

Tell your friend you have grey eyes. J'ai les yeux gris.

Our best friend is wearing a dress and you want to know the colour. What do you ask? Quelle est la couleur de ta robe?

Ask your teacher what is the colour of your friend's pencil case. Quelle est la couleur de la trousse de mon ami?

Your teacher wants to know what colour you like/ prefer. What does she ask?

Quelle couleur aimes – tu? /préfères-tu?

Your friend in Martinique wants to know your age. What does he/she ask?

Quel âge as-tu?

My aunt wants to know your friend's age. What does she ask? Quel âge a ton ami?

The teacher wants to know your sister's name/ your brother/father/your mother. What does she ask? Quel âge a ta soeur? / ton frère/ton père/ta mère

Tell the teacher you are twelve years old. J'ai douze ans.

Your grand mother ask if you have a brother. What does ask? As-tu un frère?

Tell your friend you have a sister. J'ai une soeur

Your teacher wants to know if you have any brothers or sisters. What does she ask? As-tu des frères ou des soeurs?

Tell your teacher you are the only child. Je suis fille unique. / je suis fils unique.

Your teacher wants to know how many persons are in your family. What does he/she ask? Combien de personnes y-a-t-il dans ta famille? / combien de personnes as-tu dans ta famille?

Your sister wants to know if you have a pet. What does she ask? As-tu un animal favori?

Tell you cousin you have a pet. J'ai un animal favori.

Your friend wants to know what sort of animal you have. What does he/she ask?

Quel sort d'animal as-tu?

Tell your friend you do not have an animal. Je n'ai pas d'animal

Your teacher wants to know your birthday. What does she /he ask?

Quelle est la date de ton anniversaire?/ c'est quand ton anniversaire?

Tell your friend your birthday is the 2 of January. Mon anniversaire c'est le deux janvier.

Your sister wants to know the date of your brother's birthday. What does she ask? Quelle est la date d'anniversaire de ton frère?

Your father wants to know the date of your mother's birthday. What does she ask? Quelle est la date d'anniversaire de ta mère?

You want to know what day it is. what do you ask? C'est quel jour?

You want to know which date it is. What do you ask? Quelle est la date d'aujourd'hui?

You want to know which month it is. What do you ask? C'est quel mois?

Your friend wants to know which day of the week is it. What does he/she ask?

C'est quelle semaine?

Your friend wants to know where you live. What does he/she ask?

Où habites-tu?/ Où habitez-vous?

Tell your teacher you live in St.Philip. J'habite à St. Philip

A cousin wants to know where your house is located. What does he/she ask?

Où se trouve ta maison? où est ta maison?

Your uncle wants to know where your parents live. What does he ask?

Où habitent tes parents?/ Tes parents, où habitent-ils

Tell your friend you live near the sea side/in the mountains/in the country/in a village/ in an apartment.

J'habite à coté de la mer/à la montagne/à la campagne/dans un village/dans un appartement.

Your teacher wants to know what sort of house you live in. what does he/she ask?

Dans quelle sorte de maison habites-tu? / habitez-vous

Your friend wants you to describe your house. what does he /she ask?

Peut- tu faire une description de ta maison? / Pouvez-vous faire une description de votre maison?

Tell your friend you live in a very small/big house. J'habite dans une très petite maison/ très grande maison .

Say you live in a two story house. J'habite dans une maison à deux étage.

Your teacher wants to know how many rooms you have in your house. What does he/she ask? Combien de pièces as-tu dans ta maison? / combien de pieces avez-vous dans votre maison?

Tell your cousin you have six rooms in your house. Ma maison a six pièces.

Your friend visits your home and wants to find the wash room. What does he/she ask? Où est la salle de bains?

Your teacher wants to know how many levels your house has. What does he /she ask? Combien d'étages y-a t-il dans ta maison?

A friend wants to know what sort of district you live in. What does she ask?

Dans quel sort d'endroit habites-tu?

Tell your friend you live in a quiet district/village. J'habite dans un village tranquille.

Tell you teacher you live in a noisy district/village/a lively village/a friendly village.

J'habite dans un village bruyant/ un village animé/ un village amical

You want to know the time. what do you ask? Quelle heure est-il?

Tell your friend it is 2'o clock. Il est deux heures.

Your mom wants to know at what time do you eat breakfast. What does she ask?

A quelle heure manges-tu le petit déjeuner?

Your teacher wants to know what time you wake up. What does he/she ask?

A quelle heure tu te réveilles le matin?

Tell your friend you wake up at six o'clock on morning. Je me réveille à six heures le matin.

Your friend wants to know what time you go to bed. What does he/she ask?

A quelle heure tu te couches le soir?

Tell your teacher you go to bed at 10 at night. Je me couche à 10 heures le soir.

Your uncle wants to know what you do during the day. What does he ask?

Que faites – tu pendant la journée?

Tell your uncle you watch tv/wash the dishes/go to the beach.

Je regarde la télé/ je fais les vaiselle/ je vais à la plage.

Your friend in Guadeloupe wants to know at what time do you go to school. What does he /she ask? A quelle heure vas-tu à l'école?

Your friend in Martinique wants to know at what time your school finishes. What does he/she ask? A quelle heure se termine ton école?

Your friend wants to know at what time you return home from school. what does he/she ask? A quelle heure rentres-tu à la maison?

Your mother wants to know what you do after you return home from school. What does she ask? Que faites-tu en rentrant à la maison

Je fais mes devoirs/ je mange le diner/ je joue au football/ je fais du vélo.

Your classmate wants to know what time is the French,Spanish/English

A quelle heure est la Français?/l'espanol/l'anglais.

Tell your friend you have English before geography. J'ai l'anglais avant la Géographie.

Tell your teacher you have mathematics after Spanish. J'ai les mathématiques après l'espagnol.

Your brother wants to know at what time you leave home for school. What does he ask? A quelle heure quittes-tu la maison pour aller à l'école?

Tell your teacher you leave home at eight o'clock on mornings.

Je quitte de la maison à 8 heures le matin.

Your aunt wants to know at what time your school finishes. What does she ask?

A quelle heure se termine ton école?

Your cousin wants to know at what time you leave school to return home. What does he ask? A quelle heure quittes-tu l'école pour rentrer à l'école?

Tell your friend you leave school at three o'clock to return home.

Je quitte de l'école à 3 heures pour rentrer à la maison.

Your friend wants to know if you like school. What does she ask?

Aimes-tu l'école?

Tell your teacher you like school. J'aime l'école.

Tell your teacher you do not like art. Je n'aime pas le dessin animé

Tell your teacher the colour of your school. Mon école est rouge et blanc.

The teacher wants to know what you have in your school bag. What does she ask?

Qu'est-ce que tu as dans ton sac? / Qu'est-ce que tu as dans le sac? /

You want to know what your mother's friend has in her bag. What do you ask?

Qu'est-ce qu'elle a dans son sac?

Tell your teacher you have a book/a pencil/a rubber/a pen/a pencil case in your bag. Dans mon sac j'ai un livre/un crayon/une gomme/un stylo/une trousse.
