To ask if students eat at school or at home

Someone asks you if you eat at school or at home

Ask someone what time he/she goes to bed

Ask what time someone has dinner

Ask what time someone's family has dinner

Ask what time someone does on afternoon/evenings

To exclaim what a lot of questions/homework!

Say that on Monday you have English lessons

Say what time school finishes on afternoons
